March 18, 2024 Presentation A Quilt Trip around the World by Alice Ridge




Alice Ridge joins us this month from Indiana though she has lived around the world and collected

While Silke doesn't have a webpage, she has a presence on Facebook under the FB name "Fairyfelt by Siso".

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
